OVERVIEW



Anticipating and preparing for the future is always a challenge, but in today's world of rapid technological change, increasing political instability, and rising uncertainty, business executives need new systematic and structured ways to navigate into the future. Strategic Foresight does just that by addressing the question 'How can we formulate strategy in the face of uncertainty?'

This programme will provide you with tools and the knowledge to better anticipate changes that could emerge in the future. You will learn to apply the state-of-the-art of future foresight and long-term planning. To set the context, you will identify and distinguish between various perspectives and approaches to dealing with the future.

Alongside peers, you shall explore the most current challenges in the field of future foresight, namely, the issues related to dealing with uncertainty especially when the future is

influenced by unexpected and sudden events that impact all sectors whether economic, social, technical, environmental, or otherwise. Trends in future foresight and planning and their impact will be a prime focus once the context is clear.

This programme will also give you the opportunity to develop as a leader and explore a suite of tools and frameworks for scenario planning by identifying forces that will shape future market and operating conditions; exploring how those drivers may interact; imagining a variety of plausible futures; revising mental models of the present on the basis of those futures; and then using those new models to devise strategies that prepare organizations for whatever the future actually brings.




DR PHILIPPE BOUVIER
