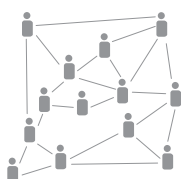
How you will be supported through the programme

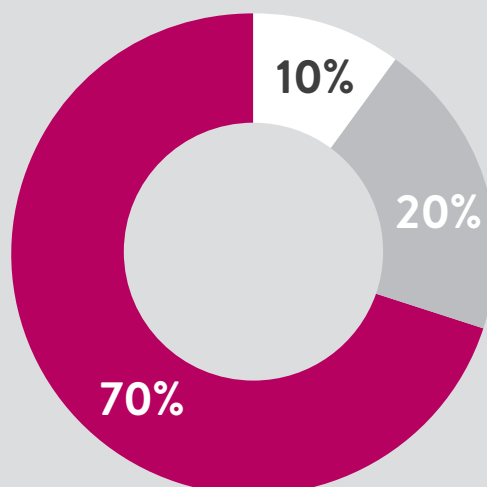

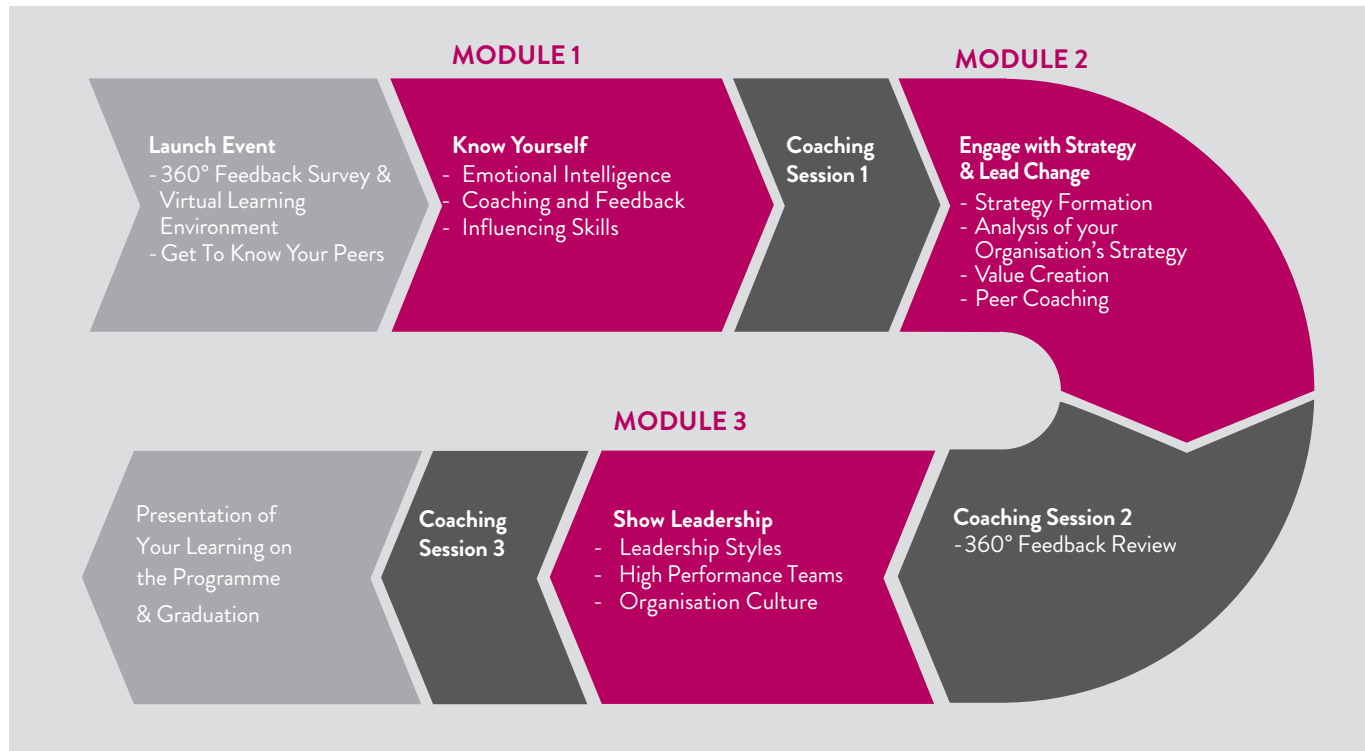
